Dr. Daniel Kiernan of OCLI Participates in Suffolk County Department of Health's Stepping On Program



On September 13, Dr. Daniel Kiernan of Ophthalmic Consultants of Long Island (OCLI) participated as a guest speaker and vision expert at a workshop for the Suffolk County Department of Health's Stepping On program. Stepping On is a program that empowers older adults to carry out health behaviors that reduce the risks of falls, improve self management, and increase quality of life.

he addressed were cataracts, macular degeneration and glaucoma. This community-based workshop was one of several offered over the course of seven weeks using adult education and self-efficacy principals.
